



## **First Call for Papers**

### **AMIS 2015 International Conference**

The Faculty of Accounting and Management Information Systems of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies, Romania, is organizing the

#### **10<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Conference on Accounting and Management Information Systems (AMIS 2015)**

to be held at the

**Bucharest University of Economic Studies, on June 10-11, 2015**

Papers are invited in the broad areas of financial accounting, managerial accounting, accounting education, auditing, financial analysis, management information systems, and business law. Authors are invited to submit theoretical and empirical contributions. All submissions will be double-blind refereed by an international scientific panel.

**This anniversary edition's keynote speaker is Mary Tokar, member of the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB).** Ms. Tokar has significant experience in the application of International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) in both developed and emerging economies, having worked in KPMG's global IFRS group with engagement teams and clients around the world in their transition to and application of IFRSs. She served as a member of the IFRS Interpretations Committee between 2001 and 2007 and was a KPMG global leader for employee benefit and share-based payment accounting. Previously, Ms. Tokar worked at the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC).

Besides the conference keynote speaker, the AMIS planning committee is in contact with various other renowned international academics, who will be available to conference delegates for live feedback and interaction during the conference.

#### **Submission details**

Submission of full papers is invited through **March 15, 2015** via the online submission system of the Conference. Abstracts will not be considered. The outcome of the review process will be communicated to authors by **May 3, 2015**. Conference participants should register for the conference before **May 17, 2015**. #### **Conference proceedings**

Electronic conference proceedings, including only the papers presented during the conference, will be submitted to ISI Thomson for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings Citation Index upon production, within several months following the conference. Proceedings of four prior editions of AMIS have been accepted for inclusion. Exclusion of papers presented from the conference proceedings is possible, upon author request.

An option for fast-track review will be given to intending authors at the *Journal of Accounting and Management Information Systems* (JAMIS).
